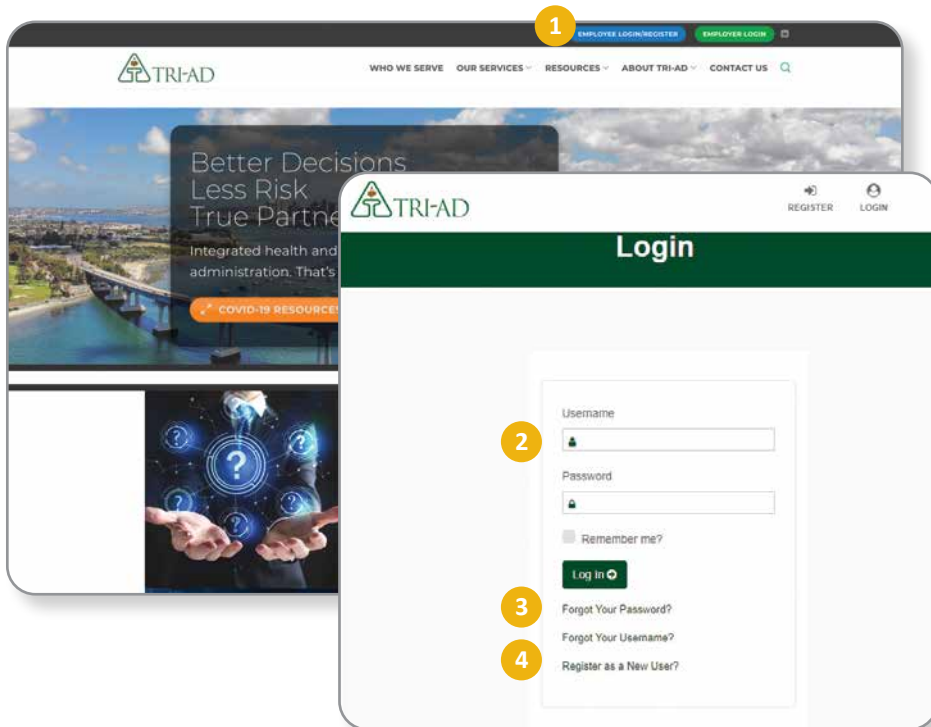




The Commuter Participant Website

Go to www.tri-ad.com to log into your account. You will need to register on our website the first time you access your account.

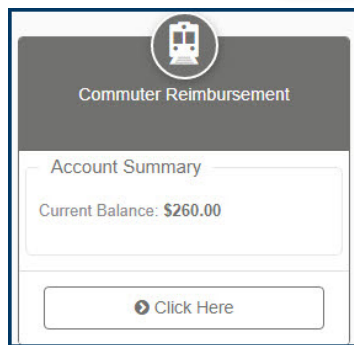


1 Click the Employee Login/ Register button to access your account.

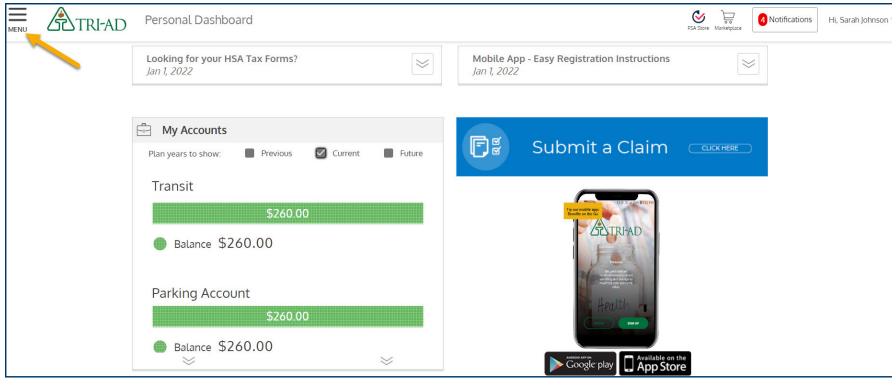

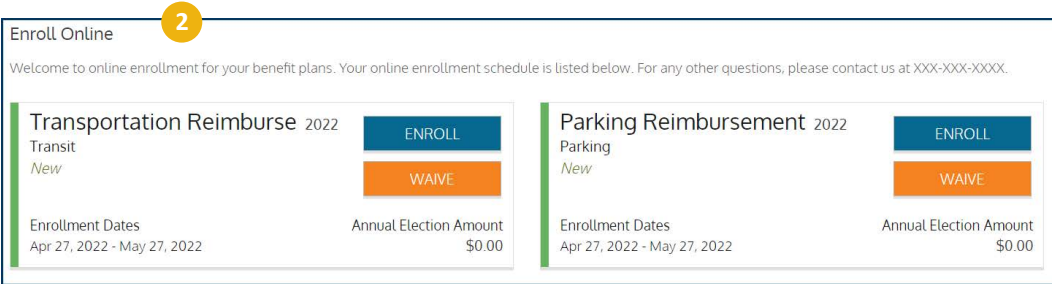


About the Commuter Participant Website
